

Dear colleagues,

As you might be aware the airline has started sending an “Availability Comms and survey” throughout the network and shortly we will all receive it in Spain.

We cannot stress enough that the whole purpose of this survey is **just informative** for the operations team .Criteria’s for return to work on Spanish bases are still in the early stages, as you know only 1 meeting has been held so far by the “Comisión de seguimiento” last 4th of May. There have been no further updates since then. As explained to you at the end of the ERTE negotiations, in case you are need to come back to work you will be advised with at least 7 days notice.

The airline wants to have a whole picture of availability around the whole network and that’s the reason that the **SAME** survey and communication is being sent through all the countries **independently from when the operations will get restarted.**

We need to manage expectations and be realistic. This survey is done on a network global scale, even though they are asking for availability for June and July , some countries like Italy or UK might resume domestic flights , **IT DOES NOT** mean that us cabin crew in Spain will return to work and fly during these months.

Sadly , as it stands right now ,bearing in mind the mobility restrictions in Spain and other countries around Europe ,we are **99,9%** sure that there will be no activity for us during June, and it is extremely possible that there will be none in July either.

As we stated before, and cannot stress enough, this is a **general communication** that has been sent all around the network. We asked the airline to reword it in order to avoid any confusion or misunderstanding, but we were told this was not possible as it was the same for all countries.
