Last week we tasted some new crew food and selected the new options that will be on board from 1st December 2023 to 1st June 2024.

Pictures will follow once the company has officially given the sign off but for your information the main changes are listed below.

Breakfast

Increase chopped fruit content by removing honey from the 3 lay up boxes with fruit

6 boxes will have jam and butter, 3 will still have honey.

Cereal removed completely

- 3 hot breakfasts (2 savoury/1 sweet)
- 3 cold breakfasts including hummus options/vegan option

We have asked Newrest if they can source MOMA porridge or similar and they are going to check if this is possible.
